** At this time, BCBS of Rochester, is forwarding their FEP subscribers' eligibility information to Medicare. Therefore, if the beneficiary has an FEP policy with BCBS of Rochester, their claims will cross automatically from Medicare. If the beneficiary has a Medigap policy with BCBS of Rochester, their subscriber identification cards will state Supplemental Policy Type A, B, F, or H. With these policy types the Medigap information should be entered on the claim. Medicare will then send the claim to BCBS of Rochester. Any other type of policy must be manually submitted to the secondary insurer.*

Please note: As of January 1, 1998, CUNA Mutual Insurance Society will no longer be participating in the automatic complementary claims transfer program with Medicare. Please send all claims in paper form to the following address:
